

Rounding means we can make calculations easier.

The results are not as accurate, but will help us to know if our final answer is likely to be correct.

We can also round decimal numbers.



Here we see 6.2437 being rounded to 3 decimal places.

The digit after the 3 is higher than 5.

So the 3 thousandths are rounded up to give 6.244

**3.4367**
